No person may receive more than two scholarships in a given year. If awarded a scholarship, the student must have at least one semester remaining at the university. Any additionally requested/supporting documentation must be provided before funds are disbursed.

The committee reserves the right to indicate acceptability of submitted and/or requested documents. Examples of acceptable documents are as follows:

- Copy of Birth Certificate
- Official Letter from the Registrar (Sent directly from the university to the UDCNAS Scholarship Email Account)
- Form I-20
- Official Transcript (Sent directly from the university to the UDCNAS Scholarship Email Account)
- Letter from USGA or GSGA Faculty Advisor

Family members of the UDCNAS executive committee are ineligible to apply for scholarships.

### **UDCNAS Scholarships**

1. The Valerie Grant Scholarship, in the amount of \$500 per award, is given (pending availability of funds) to a student who was born in Washington, D.C. Applicant must demonstrate proof that they were born in Washington, D.C., and must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher. Two letters of recommendation are required. Interview may be required. Write an essay that tells us about a proud personal achievement.
2. The Marie Racine Scholarship in the amount of \$500 per award, is given (pending availability of funds) to an international student who is currently enrolled, or plans to enroll in the upcoming semester. Applicant must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher and must demonstrate proof of international student and enrollment status. Two letters of recommendation are required. Interview may be required. Write an essay that tells us about a proud personal achievement.
3. The Patricia Chisley Scholarship, in the amount of \$500 per award, is given (pending availability of funds) to a junior or senior. Applicant must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher, and must demonstrate proof of classification. Two letters of recommendation are required. Interview may be required. Write an essay that tells us about a proud personal achievement.
4. The Mary Roberts Scholarship, in the amount of \$500 per award, is given (pending availability of funds) to a member of the Undergraduate Student Government Association, USGA or Graduate Student Government Association, GSGA. Applicant must have a 3.0 GPA and must demonstrate proof of USGA/GSGA participation. Two letters of recommendation are required. Interview may be required. Write an essay that tells us about a proud personal achievement.
5. UDC Need Based Student Grant, in the amount of \$500 per award, is given (pending availability of funds) to a student who demonstrates financial need. There is no GPA requirement for this grant. Proof of financial need is required. Two letters of recommendation are required. Interview may be required. Write an essay that describes a time you failed at something and describe how it was overcome.
6. UDC-CC Need Based Student Grant, in the amount of \$500 per award, is given (pending availability of funds) to a student who demonstrates financial need. There is no GPA requirement for this grant. Two letters of recommendation are required. Interview may be required. Write an essay that describes a time you failed at something and describe how it was overcome.
7. David A. Clarke School of Law Scholarship, in the amount of \$500 per award, is given annually to a student who is currently enrolled in the David A. Clarke School of Law. Applicant must have a GPA of 3.5 or higher. Interview may be required. Write an essay that tells us about a proud personal achievement.
8. (2) High School scholarships, in the amount of \$500 per award, are given (pending availability of funds) to a high school senior who is planning to enroll at the University of the District of Columbia. Two letters of recommendation are required. Applicant must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher. Interview may be required. Write an essay that tells us about a proud personal achievement.
